Horse Rental Agreement & Activity Waiver/Release

Please carefully read the following rental agreement and liability waiver for horseback riding and/or horse related activity at Lake Ellen Bible Camp's Lazy E Ranch (herein called LEC) before signing.

In consideration of the payment of a fee and the signing of this agreement, I, the following listed individual, and/or the parent or legal guardians thereof if a minor, do hereby agree to hire from LEC a horse, tack and equipment, personnel and trail for the purpose of instructional riding on horseback.

Protective Head Gear

I have been fully informed by LEC that I can better protect myself against head injuries by wearing ASTM approved protective equestrian head gear while mounting, riding, dismounting and being around horses. Mark an "x" below in the box before the appropriate sentence which describes your decision regarding the wearing of such equipment on the ride(s) in which you are contracting herein to participate.

I request to wear ASTM approved protective equestrian head gear which LEC will provide, understanding that these may not be of perfect fit for my head, and once provided I will be responsible for securing the protective head gear on my head at all times.

I am not a minor & refuse to wear any type of protective headgear and I accept full responsibility for this decision.

I will wear protective headgear which I, the undersigned, am providing and I will accept full responsibility for this decision. I am not relying on LEC to determine my headgear's quality or suitability.

Saddle Girth Natural Loosening

I understand that saddle girths may loosen during a ride. If a rider notices this, he/she must alert the nearest guide or wrangler as quickly as possible so action can be taken to avoid slippage of saddle and a potential fall from the animal.

Risks to Unborn Children

Because of the inherent risks of riding horses to the safety of unborn children, LEC advises pregnant women not to ride horses.

Equine Activity Waiver

I am over 18 years of age. I acknowledge that LEC is providing instruction and/or trail riding which I and/or my minor children as listed under "Registration of Riders" wish to participate. I recognize and acknowledge that my/their participation in such activities and any other activities which may include equine activities, involves the possibility of inherent risks including, but not limited to, the following:

The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine; the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; a collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; the potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant. With full knowledge of the above and any other inherent risks which may be associated with equine activities, I hereby consent to our participation in the above described activities, and I (on behalf of myself and/or my children/legal ward(s) agree to waive any and all claims for personal injury or property damage of any kind which my children, I or my heirs, personal representatives and next of kin may have or which may arise against Lake Ellen Bible Camp as a result of my/their participation in such equine activities, whether or not such injuries or damages result from negligence or legal liability. On behalf of my children herein listed, myself, my heirs, personal representatives and next of kin, I hereby release and discharge Lake Ellen Bible Camp, its successors, assigns, affiliates, directors, officers, employees and agents from any and all liabilities, claims, lawsuits, losses, costs, causes of action and damages of any kind originating or in any way arising from my/their participation in such equine activities.

I hereby declare that the terms of this Waiver and Release have been completely read, are full understood and are voluntarily accepted for the purposes of my/my children's participation in the activities described herein.

RIDING LEVELS

Level 1 - Little to no prior horse riding experience.

Level 1+ - You are comfortable around horses & riding at a walk.

Level 2 - You can ride the walk & trot with confidence and control.

Level 2+ - You can saddle & bridle a horse, ride the walk & trot with confidence & control & are ready to be introduced to the canter.

Level 3 - You can saddle & bridle a horse, ride the walk, trot & have begun to canter.

Level 3+ - You can saddle & bridle, ride the walk, trot and canter with control and confidence.

Level 4 - You can do all of the above & are ready to expand your knowledge about the horse and it's behavior.

LESSON INFORMATION

Lessons are available each season for children & adults. Complete a registration form to sign up for a lesson program. A three-week deposit (\$45) is due with the registration form. Upon arrival each week, check in at the barn to pay your weekly lesson fee (\$15).

- Week one is a mandatory session. If a student cannot attend the 1st session, a private lesson must be scheduled prior to the next scheduled session in order to continue with the lesson series.
- Lessons will not be cancelled due to rain unless the weather becomes dangerous (lightning, hail or other threatening weather, be prepared with rain gear for days when rain is in the forecast).
